DECISION AND ORDER

Duke Energy Services Canada ULC (Duke Energy) filed an application on April 7, 2021 with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB), under section 74 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) to amend its electricity generation licence EG-2020-0182.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

Duke Energy requested that the OEB amend Schedule 1 of its generation licence to include seven natural gas generating facilities located in Guelph, Ontario. The facilities will be owned and operated by the applicant. There are no other changes requested to the licence. All other provisions remain the same.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

Duke Energy Services Canada ULC 's application for amendment to Schedule 1 of its electricity generation licence EG-2020-0182 is granted.

The amended licence is attached to this Decision and Order.
