This letter is in response to your letter dated April 21, 2021, in which Fort France Power Corporation (FFPC) was granted the second year of its two-year deferral request, to defer filing its 2021 Cost of Service rate application to 2023.

As per the direction provided, FFPC will adhere to the Annual Incentive Rate-setting Index method in seeking its 2022 rate adjustment.

The letter also advised that the OEB is prepared to defer the requirement for FFPC to file a Distribution System Plan (DSP) by August 31, 2021, due to the OEB reviewing its process for how deferrals are granted in the future, as well as the ongoing COVID-19 situation. FFPC would like to thank the OEB for this consideration and accept the offer to defer filing a distribution system plan for 2022 rates.
