Background

On March 10, 2021, Enbridge Gas Inc. (EGI) applied for the clearance of 2019 balances in certain Demand Side Management deferral and variance (DSMVA) accounts.

A Notice of Hearing was issued on March 23, 2021. Procedural Order No. 1 was issued on April 20, 2021. Each of BOMA, Canadian Manufactures & Exporters (CME), Energy Probe Research Foundation (Energy Probe), Industrial Gas users Association (IGUA), Pollution Probe, School Energy Coalition (SEC) and Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition (VECC) applied for intervenor status and cost eligibility. The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) indicated that OEB staff and intervenors may file submissions on the applications by May 31, 2021.

Account Balances

We have reviewed EGI's application and responses to interrogatories. We trust that the evaluation completed, specific to the 2019 Natural Gas Demand-Side Management Annual Verification Report, were done with sufficient rigor and, therefore, BOMA has no outstanding concerns with the submitted account balances.
