## Support for Deferral

We are writing on behalf of the Federation of Rental-housing Providers of Ontario (FRPO) in response to the notification of EGI to the Board of a issues associated with the proposed disposition relative to system transitions. We are sensitive to issues of risks identified and support deferring the timing of implementation for the benefit of ratepayers and the company. At the same time, we would appreciate additional information on the new term of proposed disposition.

## **Request for Information**

To be able to support this additional adjustment and the proposed three month disposition, given the proposed start, we respectfully request the company provide additional information on the impact. In its DRO of May 14, the company provided a simple table that referred to volume forecasts differentiating the quantities for general and contract rate classes over the respective periods. This presentation made intuitive sense and given the timing available, we did not seek further information. Since the updated proposal requests deferral of implementation, we respectfully request the company provide a rate impact for each of the Union south rate zone classes providing the resulting rate impact of an October 1<sup>st</sup> start for a three month, six month and annual disposition period. This information would be helpful to the Board and ratepayers in ensuring an equitable disposition.
