Regarding: Lakefront Utilities Inc. Cost of Service Application - EB-2021-0039

Lakefront Utilities Inc. (LUI/Lakefront) confirms the following intervention requests in Lakefront's 2022 Cost of Service filing:

- 1. Cobourg Taxpayers Association
- 2. Energy Probe Research Foundation
- 3. Northumberland Hills Hospital
- 4. School Energy Coalition
- 5. Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition

Lakefront does not object to the participation of the intervenors summarized above. However, as noted in Exhibit 4, page 47, the intervenor costs included in the application were based on three intervenors (two of which are cost eligible) which was consistent with Lakefront's 2017 Cost of Service Application. Lakefront indicated in Exhibit 4 that it reserves the right to adjust the forecast of intervenor costs if additional intervenors apply for cost eligible status in the 2022 Application. Consequently, Lakefront may be required to increase the costs included in the Application based on the quantity of interrogatories received from the additional intervenors.
