GENERATE TWO PATH FENMAR GP INC. ON BEHALF OF GENERATE TWO PATH FENMAR LP

Application for an Electricity Generation Licence

DECISION AND ORDER

Generate Two Path Fenmar GP Inc. on behalf of Generate Two Path Fenmar LP (Generate Two Path) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on March 15, 2021, under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for an electricity generation licence.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

Generate Two Path was formed in January 11, 2021 and is currently building an 8MW co-generation facility that will be in-service in October 2021. The facility is located on private property and is intended to supply the existing manufacturing plant located on the same property.

After considering the application and assessing the technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue the electricity generation licence to Generate Two Path Fenmar GP Inc. on behalf of Generate Two Path Fenmar LP. The applicant is reminded of the requirement to be licenced as an electricity retailer licence, as per OEB section 57(d) in order to retail electricity to a consumer.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
