Energy Probe Research Foundation (Energy Probe) hereby applies for intervenor status and cost eligibility in EB-2021-0230, the application by Independent System Operator to the Ontario Energy Board for the approval its 2020 and 2021 Expenditures and Fees.

Statement of Interest

Energy Probe is a non-profit environmental and consumer organization which promotes economic efficiency in the use of resources. It will be representing its many individual residential customer supporters. Energy Probe argues for equitable rates that optimize results for all ratepayers by eliminating cross subsidies between ratepayer classes and between generations of ratepayers.
