DECISION AND ORDER

Demand Power Group Inc. (Demand Power) filed a complete application on April 30, 2021 under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for an electricity generation licence.

Demand Power intends to own and operate a 1.35 MW natural gas generation facility, known as Demand Power (Pride Pak). The facility will be operating under a Power Purchase agreement¹ with a large industrial customer.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

After considering the application and assessing technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue the electricity generation licence to Demand Power Group Inc.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
