This letter is in relation to Canadian Niagara Power's 2022 cost of service application. The OEB has completed a preliminary review of Canadian Niagara Power's application and requires that Canadian Niagara Power provide the following information in support of its application.

The OEB notes that at Exhibit 4, p 35 & 36, Canadian Niagara Power makes reference to certain updates to the 2021 and 2022 pension and other post-employment benefits (OPEBs) that were performed by Mercer, however, Canadian Niagara Power has not provided the related reports. Therefore, please provide the actuarial valuation to support the OPEB costs. Please also provide any documentation/reports from Mercer that support the updates made by Mercer in April 2021 for pension and November 2020 for OPEBs.

The OEB understands that Canadian Niagara Power is working with Mercer to provide the requested information at the earliest and will commence processing the application after the requested information is filed.

Please note, Canadian Niagara Power is responsible for ensuring that the documents it files with the OEB, such as its evidence, responses to interrogatories and any other supporting documentation, do not include personal information (as that phrase is

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defined in the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*), unless filed in accordance with rule 9A of the OEB's *Rules of Practice and Procedure*.
