DECISION AND ORDER

Canada Energy Wholesalers Ltd. filed an application on April 13, 2021 with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for an electricity retailer licence renewal. The licence would allow the applicant to continue retailing electricity to large and low volume consumers in Ontario.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

When evaluating applications for an electricity retailer and gas marketer licences, the OEB focuses its consideration on the requirements set out in Ontario Regulation 90/99: Licence Requirements - Electricity Retailers and Gas Marketers (Regulation). The OEB notes that the applicant has been licensed since 2006 to retail electricity and since 2020 to market natural gas. The record in this case indicates that the applicant has met the requirements set out in the Regulation and the application for an electricity retailer licence renewal is granted.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application for an electricity retailer licence is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
