DECISION AND ORDER

Carmeuse Lime (Canada) Limited filed an application on July 15, 2021, with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) pursuant to section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act* (OEB Act), for an electricity wholesaler licence renewal.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

After considering the application and assessing technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue the electricity wholesaler licence to Carmeuse Lime (Canada) Limited.

Carmeuse Lime (Canada) Limited failed to renew its previous electricity wholesaler licence EW-2015-0258 before it expired on October 14, 2020. The applicant has been operating without a licence, in contravention of section 57 of the OEB Act, and may be subject to an OEB compliance proceeding. The decision to approve and issue a licence to Carmeuse Lime (Canada) Limited is without prejudice with regard to any future compliance actions. The applicant is reminded that it carries the onus of filing an application in a timely manner considering the OEB's typical timelines for processing licence applications.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
