**RE: EB-2021-0136 – Hydro One Networks Inc. – Richview to Trafalgar Reconductoring Project – Capital Power Corporation (“Capital Power”) Request for Intervenor Status**

Capital Power hereby requests intervenor status in Ontario Energy Board (“OEB” or “Board”) proceeding EB-2021-0136 (the “Proceeding”).

The Proceeding concerns an application by Hydro One seeking an Order or Orders from the Board granting leave to reconductor existing transmission line circuits between Richview Transformer Station and Trafalgar Transformer Station (the “transmission facilities”), thereby increasing transfer capability on the *Flow East Towards Toronto* (“FETT”) interface by approximately 2000 MW.

Capital Power is both a customer of Hydro One and an active participant in Ontario’s wholesale electricity market with commercial interests that include ownership and operation of several existing generating facilities, as well as the potential development of new projects in the Province. These interests stand to be directly impacted by the Board’s decision in this Proceeding. Specifically, Capital Power wishes to address the extent to which the reconductoring of line circuits between the transmission facilities may directly impact future Locational Marginal Pricing (“LMP”) and competition in the wholesale market for electricity, deliverability obligations of existing suppliers, and the extent to which alternative solution options were considered.

Capital Power wishes to file interrogatories, participate in the hearing, review and test evidence, and make submissions addressing issues it deems material to its interests. Capital Power is not seeking a cost award.
