Considering these 3 factors regarding my hydro service in grey county, I strongly oppose any increase to hydro rates in my area.

1. My rates have increased approximately 50% in the last 4 years which not coincidentally mirror the current political administration.

2. Even though I currently have access to high speed internet at speeds that rival any metropolitan centre, Hydro One doesn't seem to be able to offer time of day pricing to help me reduce my costs. Hydro One offered this plan 20 years ago at my former residence outside of Guelph. UPGRADES?????
PLEASE????

3. The final straw that has broken my will: due to Hydro Ones' outdated and draconian system, they do not have the "capacity" at my relevant transfer station for me to install solar panels on my house. I was intending to access the net metering system with Hydro One but they will not allow this upgrade that I was willing to pay for. This is even more ludicrous as they have just adopted a commercial solar array at the same substation.
