Ontario Hydro was given a monopoly in order to fairly supply the entire population with electricity and prevent other companies from cherry picking easy profits from high density areas and leaving low density areas to be covered at exorbitant cost.

EB-2021-0110 presents the exact scenario the granting of the monopoly was given to prevent. The philosophy that low density customers should bear the entire cost of hydro delivery to them (as well as pay a much higher price for that electricity with no difference in the cost of generation), is simple monopoly greed.

At present as HydroOne customers < 2000 kw/hr we are paying \$78.21 per month for 12 months per year delivery charges.
The year 1 increase requested is \$9.22 total

This is a 11.89% increase

The 5 year increase request is \$37.20

This is a 47.59% increase

These increases are exorbitant especially when compared to city based customers.

We only use electricity for 6 months but will be paying \$1384.92 per year to deliver less than 2000 kw/hr or at a max rate of \$.17 — \$340.00 of electricity. This outrageous.

Again the point of making a monopoly to deliver electricity was fair overall pricing please consider this when making your decision.
