Response to Procedural Order No. 1 -

Participation by the Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition (VECC)

On September 17, 2021 the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) issued Procedural Order No. 1 in the Hydro One Networks Inc. (Hydro One) proceeding EB-2021-0110. VECC has been granted intervenor status and cost eligibility in this proceeding. That Order sets out the bifurcation of certain issues related to the UTR and ETS rates under the docket EB-2021-0243 and requests that parties identify if they wish to participate in either or both proceedings.
