**Re: Request for Intervenor Status and Cost Eligibility  
Hydro One Networks Inc.  
2023-2027 Transmission and Distribution Joint Rate Application  
Ontario Energy Board File Number: EB-2021-0110**

This letter is in response to your letter dated September 23, 2021, filed on behalf of Environmental Defence (ED), requesting intervenor status and cost eligibility in the above proceeding.

The OEB notes that ED's intervention request was filed after the September 14, 2021, deadline for requesting intervention status and cost eligibility had passed. ED explained that the late filing was because Hydro One Networks Inc. had inadvertently not served it with the Notice. ED also stated that if it is accepted as an intervenor, it will not cause any delay or require any changes to the schedule set out in Procedural Order No.1 dated September 17, 2021.

Hydro One Networks Inc. confirmed it will not object to this request.

ED is approved as an intervenor and is eligible to apply for an award of costs under the OEB's *Practice Direction on Cost Awards*.
