**Re: Ontario Energy Board
Enbridge Gas Inc. – 2020 Federal Carbon Pricing Program Application
Cost Award Eligibility – Chiefs of Ontario - OEB File Number: EB-2019-0247**

On September 24, 2021, the Chief of Ontario (COO) filed a letter with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) seeking cost eligibility in the above noted proceeding. In its letter, the COO stated the following:

The Board's decision dated August 13, 2020 listed the Chiefs of Ontario as being granted intervenor status and cost eligibility, as did the decision on Costs awards dated September 21, 2020 which indicated that Chiefs of Ontario would be granted intervenor status and cost award eligibility. This led prior counsel and Chiefs of Ontario to believe its costs would be eligible. While Chiefs of Ontario did not specify it would seek costs in its letter of intervention, there was a change of counsel between the date of sending the letter and the submissions.

The OEB has reviewed the request for cost eligibility and will permit COO to file a cost award claim for consideration. The OEB accepts that there was an oversight upon the change of COO's legal representative.

The COO is required to meet the same deadlines as Anwaatin Inc. for filing a cost award claim as specified in the OEB's Decision and Order issued on September 23, 2021.
