Re: LIEN Intervenor Status Request - Union Gas Submission (Board File No. EB-2008-0106)

In response to the Board's letter dated July 17, 2008, Union Gas Limited ("Union") has no objection to the Low-Income Energy Network ("LIEN") receiving intervenor status for the above-noted proceeding.

Union would, however, like to comment on the effort of LIEN to expand the scope of the EB-2008-0106 proceeding as noted in its Intervention and Cost Eligibility Request dated July 15, 2008:

"LIEN intends to seek the development of a bill assistance strategy for low-income consumers that includes the establishment of a low-income assistance rate."

Union submits the Board has already initiated a proceeding (EB-2008-0150) whose focus is to examine issues associated with low-income energy consumers in relation to their use of natural gas and electricity. In Union's view, the issues identified by LIEN clearly fall within the scope and intent of EB-2008-0150. Thus, there is no basis for a review of these issues as part of this proceeding. Union received the letter from Aird & Berlis LLP sent on behalf of Enbridge Gas Distribution of today's date. Union adopts the comments made by Enbridge in respect of LIEN's intervention.
