Re: Low Income Energy Network (LIEN) Notice of Withdrawal Elexicon Energy Inc. ("Elexicon") Application to raise its electricity distribution rates for its Veridian rate zone and Whitby rate zone ("Application") OEB File No. EB-2021-0015

Willms & Shier Environmental Lawyers LLP is counsel for the Low-Income Energy Network ("LIEN"). On September 23, 2021, LIEN requested eligibility to intervene in Elexicon's application to raise its electricity distribution rates for its Veridian rate zone and Whitby rate zone, effective January 1, 2022, and also sought eligibility for a cost award.

LIEN requested eligibility to intervene on the basis that Elexicon was also seeking approval of its Distribution System Plan ("DSP"). However, we now understand from Elexicon's counsel's letter sent on September 30, 2021 that Elexicon is not seeking approval of its DSP.

Given this, LIEN hereby withdraws its request for eligibility to intervene in Elexicon's Application.
