Application for electricity distribution rates effective January 1, 2022

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1 October 4, 2021

Energy+ Inc. (Energy+) filed an incentive rate-setting mechanism application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on August 16, 2021 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B) seeking approval for changes to its electricity distribution rates to be effective January 1, 2022.

A Notice of Hearing was issued on September 1, 2021. Each of School Energy Coalition (SEC), Toyota Motor Manufacturing Canada Inc. (TMMC), Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition (VECC) applied for intervenor status. SEC and VECC also applied for cost eligibility.

No objection was received from Energy+ .

SEC, TMMC and VECC are approved as intervenors. The list of parties in this proceeding is attached as Schedule A to this Procedural Order. SEC and VECC are eligible to apply for an award of costs under the OEB's *Practice Direction on Cost Awards* and only in relation to Energy+'s request for incremental funding for the Southworks Project.

Being eligible to apply for recovery of costs is not a guarantee of recovery of any costs claimed. Cost awards are made by way of OEB order at the end of a hearing.

It is necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. Further procedural orders may be issued by the OEB.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. OEB staff and intervenors shall request any relevant information and documentation from Energy+ that is in addition to the evidence already filed, by written interrogatories filed with the OEB and served on Energy+ and all other parties by **October 14, 2021**.

- 2. Energy+ shall file with the OEB complete written responses to the interrogatories and serve them on all intervenors by **October 28, 2021**.
- 3. Any written submissions by OEB staff and intervenors shall be filed with the OEB and served on all other parties by **November 11, 2021**.
- 4. Energy+ may file a written reply submission with the OEB and serve it on intervenors by **November 25, 2021**.

Parties are responsible for ensuring that any documents they file with the OEB, such as applicant and intervenor evidence, interrogatories and responses to interrogatories or any other type of document, **do not include personal information** (as that phrase is defined in the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*), unless filed in accordance with rule 9A of the OEB's Rules of Practice and Procedure.
