Please deny London' Hydro's application for rate increases starting in May, 2022. Given the circumstances, London Hydro should be providing their customers a rate reduction. As with many residential customers, I have been working from home for more than 1-1/2 years, due to work restrictions related to the COVID-19 pandemic. Setting-up an adequate office with the necessary electronic equipment (phones, computers, additional heating and A/C use) has increased our electrical use, along with our monthly hydro bill.

For example, my pre-pandemic hydro bill (Spring 2020) was typically \$220-\$240 per month; in Fall 2021 the same bill is typically \$340-\$380 (last month was \$431.90). I understand London Hydro's request, however the timing could not be worse.
