Re: Canadian Niagara Power Inc.

2022 Transmission Revenue Requirement

Ontario Energy Board File Number: EB-2021-0176

In its January 14, 2016, Decision and Order¹, the OEB approved a 2016 revenue requirement of \$4,647,201 for Canadian Niagara Power Inc. (CNPI) through a cost of service application. CNPI has not applied for transmission revenue requirements other than foregone revenue and interest disposition since that time.

The OEB is in the process of approving individual transmitters' 2022 revenue requirements and establishing the 2022 Uniform Transmission Rates (UTRs). In the 2021 UTRs, CNPI's approved transmission revenue requirement of \$5,075,626 included 2017 and 2020 forgone revenue and interest. Could you please confirm by November 5, 2021 that CNPI will not be submitting a 2022 transmission revenue requirement application or seeking any adjustments to the approved revenue requirement of \$4,647,201 for 2022?
