DECISION AND ORDER

H2O Power Limited Partnership filed an application on August 4, 2021 with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB), pursuant to section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act* (OEB Act), for a large volume electricity retailer licence renewal. The licence would allow the applicant to continue retailing electricity to large volume consumers in Ontario.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority without a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

After considering the application and assessing the applicant's technical capability, financial viability and conduct, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue a large volume electricity retailer licence to H2O Power Limited Partnership.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application for a large volume electricity retailer licence is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
