EB-2021-0110: Custom Incentive Rate-setting Application for 2023-2027 Distribution Rates and Transmission Revenue Requirement ("Application") Filing of the Updated Confidential Labour Relations Strategy Appendix (the Appendix)

We are counsel to Hydro One, the applicant in the above-referenced proceeding. On October 25, 2021, the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) issued its decision on confidential treatment of the Appendix, among other things. The OEB found that the Appendix, other than the first paragraph of the introduction, shall be treated as confidential as it contains specific labour relations strategy and objectives associated with upcoming negotiations with the unions, disclosure of which could prejudice Hydro One's position in these negotiations. Regarding the introduction of the Appendix, the OEB found that the first paragraph (Lines 3 to 7) did not require confidential treatment and directed Hydro One to file it on the public record. In accordance with the OEB's decision, the updated Appendix is provided in Appendix A below.






