DECISION AND ORDER

Exelon Generation Company, LLC (Exelon Generation) filed an application on August 12, 2021, with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) pursuant to section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act), for a renewal of its electricity wholesaler licence.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

The applicant has been previously licensed by the OEB and applied on August 12, 2021 to renew its electricity wholesaler licence, which was set to expire on September 28, 2021. An Interim Decision and Order extending the licence term to February 2, 2022, was issued on September 2, 2021.

After considering the technical and financial capability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue the electricity wholesaler licence to Exelon Generation Company, LLC. The OEB notes the application was filed by the applicant 48 days prior to the expiration of the existing licence and takes this opportunity to remind the applicant and all existing licencees that they must ensure their renewal application is filed in time to permit the OEB to undertake its review and issue a licence prior to the expiry of an existing licence.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
