IN THE MATTER OF the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O.1998, c.15, (Schedule B);

AND IN THE MATTER OF an application by Ontario Power Generation Inc. pursuant to section 78.1 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* for an Order or Orders determining payment amounts for the output of certain of its generating facilities.

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 6

The Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") received an application from Ontario Power Generation Inc. ("OPG") on November 30, 2007, under section 78.1 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c.15, Schedule B (the "Act"), seeking approval for increases in payment amounts for the output of certain of its generating facilities, to be effective April 1, 2008. The Board assigned the application file number EB-2007-0905 and issued a Notice of Application and Oral Hearing dated December 13, 2007.

The oral hearing concluded on June 20, 2008. Intervenors have filed their arguments with the Board and OPG is expected to file its reply argument by August 5, 2008.

Cost Claims

Intervenors who are eligible to claim costs in this proceeding are to file their final claims as ordered below. Intervenors should note that they are to file two separate claims, each with related Forms. One claim will be for costs incurred to June 20, 2008 and the other for costs incurred after June 20, 2008.

Further procedural orders may be issued from time to time.

THE BOARD THEREFORE ORDERS THAT:

- Eligible intervenors claiming costs in the EB-2007-0905 proceeding are to file their final claims in accordance with the Board's *Practice Direction on Cost Awards* within 7 days after OPG has filed its reply argument. Two separate claims are to be filed, one for costs incurred to June 20, 2008 and the other for costs incurred after June 20, 2008.
- 2. OPG shall have until 14 calendar days from the date the cost claim was filed to object to any aspect of the costs claimed.
- 3. The party claiming costs shall have 7 calendar days from the date of filing of the objections to file a reply.
- 4. All filings to the Board must quote file number EB-2007-0905, be made through the Board's web portal at www.errr.oeb.gov.on.ca, and consist of two paper copies and one electronic copy in searchable / unrestricted PDF format. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Please use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at www.oeb.gov.on.ca. If the web portal is not available you may email your document to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD or diskette in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies. All communications should be directed to the attention of the Board Secretary at the address below, and be received no later than 4:45 p.m. on the required date.
