Decision and Order

EDF Renewables NW Storage LP (EDF Renewables NW) filed a complete application on October 15, 2021, with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for an electricity storage licence.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

EDF Renewables NW has applied to own and operate a battery storage facility that has an installed capacity of 4MW and is located at the Great Lake Copper facility in London, Ontario.

After considering the technical and financial capability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue the electricity storage licence to EDF Renewables NW Storage LP.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

The application by EDF Renewables NW Storage LP for an electricity storage licence is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence
