DECISION AND ORDER

DTE Lake Erie Generation, Inc. (DTE Lake Erie) filed a complete application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on October 1, 2021 under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for an electricity generation licence.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

The applicant has applied for an electricity generation licence to own and operate a 68MW steam turbine generator (STG) within the property of Stelco Inc.'s integrated steel production facility known as the Lake Erie Works, located in Nanticoke, Ontario ("Stelco Facility"). DTE Lake Erie STG has entered into an agreement to supply power to the Stelco Facility.

After considering the application and assessing the technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue the electricity generation licence to DTE Lake Erie.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. DTE Lake Erie Generation, Inc.'s application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
