INTERIM DECISION AND ORDER

CAP Power, LP filed an application on October 21, 2021, with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) pursuant to section 60 (1) of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act), for a renewal of its large volume electricity retailer licence.

CAP Power, LP's electricity retailer licence ER-2016-0238 expired on October 19, 2021. In order for the applicant to continue retailing electricity to large volume consumers in Ontario, the applicant requires an electricity retailer licence pursuant to section 57 (d) of the OEB Act.

Considering the time required to process an application in accordance with the OEB's established practice and procedures, and considering the applicant's need for a licence to carry out activities as an electricity retailer, the OEB finds it expedient to extend the term of the licence ER-2016-0238, pending the final disposition of the matter. This Decision and Order does not constitute a final decision on the application.

The applicant is reminded that it carries the onus of filing an application in a timely manner considering the OEB's typical timelines for processing licence applications.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

The term of CAP Power, LP's large volume electricity retailer licence ER-2016-0238 is extended until January 31, 2022, or until the final determination of the electricity retailer licence application, whichever is earlier. All other conditions of licence ER-2016-0238 remain unchanged.
