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1 OVERVIEW

This is the final Rate Order an application filed by Lakefront Utilities Inc. to change its electricity distribution rates to be effective January 1, 2022.

The OEB has reviewed Lakefront Utilities draft rate order, proposed Tariff of Rates and Charges, and reply comments on its draft rate order and is satisfied that they accurately reflect the Decision and Order issued on October 28, 2021¹.

As a result of this Final Rate Order, it is estimated that for a typical residential customer with a monthly consumption of 750 kWh, the total bill will increase by \$5.82 per month, or 4.77% before taxes and the Ontario Electricity Rebate.

2 CONTEXT AND PROCESS

The OEB issued its Decision and Order on the application on October 28, 2021. In the Decision, the OEB ordered Lakefront Utilities to file a draft rate order reflecting the updated 2022 cost of capital parameters, the most recent Regulated Price Plan Report and Smart Meter Entity Charge. The Decision allowed for comments on the draft rate order by OEB staff and intervenors and reply comments by Lakefront Utilities.

On November 4, 2021, Lakefront Utilities filed its draft rate order with proposed Tariff of Rates and Charges. On November 11, 2021, OEB staff filed its submission on the draft rate order and submitted that revisions were required to meet the requirements of the Decision.

No submissions from intervenors were received on the draft rate order.

On November 18, 2021 Lakefront Utilities filed a revised draft rate order with proposed Tariff of Rates and Charges reflecting the OEB staff's submission. On November 22, 2021 OEB staff filed a submission on the revised draft rate order and submitted that Lakefront Utilities had accurately reflected the Decision.

3 FINDINGS

The OEB has reviewed the information provided in support of Lakefront Utilities' draft rate order and Tariff of Rates and Charges effective January 1, 2022, as revised. The OEB finds that the revised draft rate order accurately reflects the Decision.

As noted in the Decision, certain Service Charges are subject to annual inflationary adjustments to be determined by the OEB through a generic order. The settlement proposal updated the applicable energy retailer service charges in the Tariff of Rates and Charges by using the OEB's 2021 inflation rate as a placeholder.² Parties agreed this would be updated when the generic order is issued by the OEB.³

The generic order has now been issued in EB-2021-0301. The OEB has adjusted the energy retailer service charges in the approved Tariff of Rates and Charges included as Schedule A to this Final Rate Order, to reflect the impact of the EB-2021-0301 Decision and Order.

In addition, the OEB has made some minor changes to the formatting of the proposed Tariff of Rates and Charges filed by Lakefront Utilities to ensure consistency with the tariff sheets of other Ontario electricity distributors.

4 DECISION ON THE DRAFT RATE ORDER

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:

 The Tariff of Rates and charges set out in Schedule A is effective January 1, 2022 and is to be implemented January 1, 2022. The Tariff of Rates and Charges will apply to electricity consumed or estimated to have been consumed on and after January 1, 2022. Lakefront Utilities Inc. shall notify its customers of the rate change no later than the delivery of the first bill reflecting the new final rates.
