EPCOR Natural Gas Limited Partnership

Application for natural gas distribution rates beginning January 1, 2022

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 2 November 30, 2021

EPCOR Natural Gas Limited Partnership (EPCOR) filed an incentive rate-setting mechanism application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on September 27, 2021 under section 36 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, *1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B) seeking approval for changes to the rates that EPCOR charges for natural gas distribution in its South Bruce service area, beginning January 1, 2022.

Procedural Order No. 1 was issued on November 3, 2021 which provisioned for interrogatories, submissions and a reply submission. OEB staff filed a submission on November 19, 2021. EPCOR filed a partial reply submission on November 29, 2021.

In a letter dated November 29, 2021, EPCOR requested an extension to the date for the filing of EPCOR's remaining reply submission from November 29, 2021 to December 1, 2021. EPCOR requested an extension because additional time is required to comprehensively and accurately address OEB Staff comments regarding the Municipal Tax Variance Account.

The OEB will grant the request to file a complete reply submission by December 1, 2021.

It is necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. Further procedural orders may be issued by the OEB.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. A complete reply submission by EPCOR shall be filed with the OEB by **December 1, 2021**.

Parties are responsible for ensuring that any documents they file with the OEB, such as applicant and intervenor evidence, interrogatories and responses to interrogatories or any other type of document, **do not include personal information** (as that phrase is

defined in the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*), unless filed in accordance with rule 9A of the OEB's <u>Rules of Practice and Procedure</u>.
