DECISION AND ORDER

Bruce Power Net Zero Inc. (Bruce Power Net Zero) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on October 7, 2021, under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for an electricity generation licence renewal.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

The application is for the renewal of electricity generation licence EG-2001-0786, which is set to expire on January 10, 2022. EG-2001-0786 was issued to Huron Wind Inc. (Huron Wind) and authorizes it to own and operate a 9MW wind farm, located in Tiverton, Ontario. On September 2, 2021, Huron Wind changed its legal name to Bruce Power Net Zero. As part of its application for a licence, the applicant submitted a request to change the name on the licence which was supported by a Certificate and Article of Amendment.

After considering the technical and financial capability of the applicant the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to approve both the name change and to issue an electricity generation licence to Bruce Power Net Zero.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The application for a name change is granted.
- 2. The application for a new licence is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
