Dear Ms. Long:

I am writing pursuant to the Ontario Energy Board's (OEB) Notice dated November 30, 2021 regarding the above proceeding to request an extension to January 2022 to file AMPCO's comments.

In order to understand the current level of effectiveness and accuracy of the reliability policy framework and reporting, OEB staff has completed an analysis of distributors' reported data and identified a high-level set of issues for discussion with stakeholders. The issues focus on four areas: enhancing utility accountability, customer-specific reliability, monitoring utility performance, and supporting effective utility planning.

The OEB is looking for comments and feedback from stakeholders by December 22, 2021 on these potential issues based on a series of questions included in Appendix A to the OEB's November 30, 2021 Notice. In order for AMPCO to effectively consult with its membership on the identified issues, AMPCO requires more time. AMPCO respectfully asks that the OEB please provide AMPCO with an extension to January 7, 2022 to provide comments.
