DECISION AND ORDER

Eastern Power Inc (EPI) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on October 15, 2021 under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for an electricity generation licence.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

EPI is currently building a 600MW natural gas and hydrogen generation facility that will be in commercial service on March 31, 2025. The facility will be located on leased land from Greenfield South Power Corporation on Oil Springs Line, St. Clair Township.

After considering the application and assessing the technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue the electricity generation licence to Eastern Power Inc.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
