DECISION AND ORDER

Weyerhaeuser Company Limited filed an application on October 14, 2021, with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) pursuant to section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act* (OEB Act), for an electricity wholesaler licence.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

After considering the application and assessing the technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue an electricity wholesaler licence to Weyerhaeuser Company Limited.

Weyerhaeuser Company Limited has been purchasing power in the IESO-administered market without the requisite OEB licence since 2006, in contravention of section 57(e) of the OEB Act, and may be subject to an OEB compliance proceeding. The decision to approve and issue a licence to Weyerhaeuser Company Limited is without prejudice to any future compliance and enforcement actions that may be taken by the OEB.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
