**DECISION AND ORDER**

CAP Power, LP filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on October 29, 2021 under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for a renewal of its large volume electricity retailer licence. The licence would allow the applicant to continue retailing electricity to large volume consumers in Ontario.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act. Given the timing of its current licence's expiry, an Interim Decision extending CAP Power, LP's existing licence was issued by the OEB on November 18, 2021.

After considering the application and assessing the technical capability, financial viability and conduct of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue the large volume electricity retailer licence to CAP Power, LP.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
