BPI's distribution system is made up of 275 km of overhead lines and 259 km of underground lines. BPI distributes power at a primary voltage of 27.6 kV, but maintains some small pockets of 8.32 kV and 4.16 kV. BPI jointly owns Powerline Municipal Transformer Station ("PMTS") with Energy+ Inc. As of 2021, the total station capacity in BPI's service area was approximately 234 MVA. BPI no longer owns or operates any municipal substations.
Energy+'s system is made up of 980 km of overhead circuits and 506 km of underground circuits. Energy+ distributes power at a primary voltage of 27.6 kV. Energy+ owns transformer station Municipal Transformer Station #1 and jointly owns PMTS with BPI. As at 2018, the total station capacity for Energy+'s service area was approximately 864 MVA.
