DECISION AND ORDER

Sault Ste Marie Energy Storage LP (SSMES) filed an application on November 29, 2021, with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) pursuant to section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act), for a renewal of its electricity storage licence.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

SSMES owns and operates a 7MW lithium-ion battery storage facility located in Sault Ste. Marie, Ontario, which has been in operation since 2018.

After considering the application and assessing technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to renew the application and issue the electricity storage licence to Sault Ste Marie Energy Storage LP.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
