Re: Toyota Motor Manufacturing Canada Inc. ("TMMC") - Application for Renewal of Electricity Wholesaler Licence - OEB File No. EB-2017-0014

We are writing on behalf of Toyota Motor Manufacturing Canada Inc. ("TMMC") to file an application (in electronic form and including six attachments) for renewal of TMMC's Electricity Wholesaler Licence EB-2017-0014 which expires on February 8, 2022. TMMC also requests that the Ontario Energy Board ("Board") issue, on an urgent basis, an order for an interim Electricity Wholesaler Licence, authorizing TMMC to continue to participate in the Independent Electricity System Operator ("IESO")-administered electricity market, pending the Board's disposition on TMMC's application for a new licence.


TMMC operates three automobile manufacturing facilities in Ontario. One of these--the Woodstock Plant—is connected to the provincial electricity grid and purchases its electricity requirements in IESO-administered markets. Participation in such markets requires an Electricity Wholesaler Licence pursuant to section 57 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* ("OEB Act"). Without a current licence, TMMC would be in breach of the OEB Act and of the IESO's Market Rules.

TMMC understands that it bears the onus of filing applications for required authorizations in a timely manner, having regard to the Board's typical application processing timelines, and has done just that in respect of its two previous renewal applications. Unfortunately, circumstances made it impossible to do so in this case. Although TMMC commenced the process of preparing its renewal application a number of months ago, material challenges facing TMMC resulted in significant delays in finalizing and filing the application.

In the result, TMMC requires interim licence authorization, pending disposition of its application for a final licence.

Application for an Electricity Wholesaler Licence

Application Instructions

1. Purpose of this Form

Use this form to apply, under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act), for an “electricity wholesaler” licence. An electricity wholesaler licence issued by the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) enables the licensee to purchase electricity or ancillary services in the Independent Electricity System Operator (IESO) administered markets or directly from a generator; and to sell electricity or ancillary services through the IESO-administered markets or directly to another person, other than a consumer.

2. Completion Instructions

This form is in writeable PDF and can be completed electronically. If necessary, **responses may be continued on additional pages**. The applicant is encouraged to complete the form electronically, save the completed form and file it, along with any attachments, by e-mail to: boardsec@oeb.ca.

All other information filed as part of or in support of this application will be placed on the public record. Where the applicant objects to public disclosure of information filed as part of or in support of sections other than sections 9 to 13, the applicant must follow the procedure set out in the OEB's Practice Direction on Confidential Filings.

5. Important Information

Applicants should consider the timelines required to process applications to avoid submitting applications too early or too late. Submitting applications too early without reasonable certainty of the proposed licensed activities will impede regulatory efficiency while submitting applications too late will leave the applicant to bear the risk of delayed commencement of licensed activities. If submitted incomplete, there may be a delay in processing the application.
