# ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD NOTICE TO CUSTOMERS OF ENBRIDGE GAS INC.

Exhibit A

**Enbridge Gas Inc. has applied for approval to dispose of certain account balances.**

**Learn more. Have your say.**

Enbridge Gas Inc. has applied to the Ontario Energy Board for approval to clear amounts recorded in certain 2020 deferral and variance accounts related to its delivery of natural gas conservation and energy efficiency programs.

If the application is approved as filed, a typical residential customer in the EDG Rate Zone and in the Union Rate Zones (former customers of Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. and Union Gas Limited, respectively) would see the following change to be applied as a one-time billing adjustment effective as soon as July 1, 2022:

- A typical residential customer in the EDG Rate Zone would see a one-time charge of \$4.28
- A typical residential customer in the Union South Rate Zone would see a one-time charge of \$1.11
- A typical residential customer in the Union North Rate Zone would see a one-time refund of \$5.20

**Other customers, including businesses may also be affected.**

## THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD WILL HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) will hold a public hearing to consider Enbridge Gas's application. During this hearing, which could be an oral or written hearing, we will question Enbridge Gas on the case. We will also hear questions and arguments from individuals that have registered to participate (called intervenors) in the OEB's hearing. At the end of this hearing, the OEB will decide whether to approve Enbridge Gas's requests.

The OEB is an independent and impartial public agency. We make decisions that serve the public interest. Our goal is to promote a financially viable and efficient energy sector that provides you with reliable energy services at a reasonable cost.

The OEB intends to consider cost awards in this proceeding that are in accordance with the *Practice Direction on Cost Awards* and only in relation to the review of the 2020 Demand Side Management variance account balances and the allocation of any disposed amounts for all three deferral and variance accounts. The OEB will not consider future DSM program or plan issues as they are being addressed as part of EB-2021-0002.

## BE INFORMED AND HAVE YOUR SAY

You have the right to information regarding this application and to be involved in the process.

- You can review Enbridge Gas's application on the OEB's website now
- You can file a letter with your comments, which will be considered during the hearing
- You can become an intervenor. As an intervenor you can ask questions about Enbridge Gas's application and make arguments on whether the OEB should approve Enbridge Gas's request. Apply by **February 18, 2022** or the hearing will go ahead without you and you will not receive any further notice of the proceeding
- At the end of the process, you can review the OEB's decision and its reasons on our website

The scope of the OEB's review in the proceeding is limited to the review of the 2020 account balances and the allocation of any disposed amounts. Therefore, the OEB will not consider any matters related to the 2015-2020 DSM Guidelines that are not directly related to the determination of the disposition and allocation of the 2020 account balances.

Enbridge Gas Inc. a déposé une requête en vue de liquider certains montants enregistrés dans certains comptes de report et d'écart de 2020 dans le cadre de sa prestation de programmes de conservation du gaz naturel et d'efficacité énergétique.

Si cette requête est approuvée dans sa forme actuelle, les clients résidentiels types des zones de tarification d'EGD et d'Union (anciennement des clients d'Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. et d'Union Gas Limited, respectivement) verraient les changements suivants s'appliquer sous la forme d'un rajustement unique de la facturation à compter du 1<sup>er</sup> juillet 2022 :

### APPLICATION

1. Enbridge Gas Inc. (“Enbridge Gas” or the “Company”), was formed by the amalgamation of Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. (“EGD”) and Union Gas Limited (“Union”), on January 1, 2019 pursuant to the *Ontario Business Corporations Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. B. 16. Enbridge Gas carries on the business of selling, distributing, transmitting and storing natural gas in Ontario within the meaning of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998 (the “Act”).
2. EGD and Union (collectively, referred to as the “Utilities”) filed an application dated November 2, 2017 with the Ontario Energy Board (“OEB”) pursuant to section 43(1) of the Act for an order or orders granting leave to amalgamate into a single company, referred to as “Amalco”, effective January 1, 2019.<sup>1</sup> On November 23, 2017, the Utilities applied to the OEB pursuant to section 36 of the Act, for an order approving a rate setting mechanism and associated parameters for the deferred rebasing period, effective January 1, 2019.<sup>2</sup> The OEB issued its Decision and Order for the amalgamation and rate setting mechanism (the “MAADs Decision”) on August 30, 2018.

3. Enbridge Gas hereby applies to the OEB pursuant to Section 36 of the Act and pursuant to the MAADs Decision for such final or interim Orders and Accounting Orders as necessary approving the final balances in the 2020 Demand Side Management (“DSM”) Deferral and Variance Accounts (set out in Table 1 and Table 2 – excluding interest) and the disposition of these balances within the next available Quarterly Rate Adjustment Mechanism (“QRAM”) application following the OEB’s approval,<sup>3</sup> effective as soon as July 1, 2022: (i) for the EGD rate zone through a one-time adjustment in rates; and (ii) for the Union rate zones,<sup>4</sup> through a one-time adjustment in rates.

4. Enbridge Gas further applies to the OEB for all necessary Orders and Directions concerning pre-hearing and hearing procedures necessary for the determination of this application.

The persons affected by this Application are the customers resident or located in the municipalities, police villages, and Indigenous communities served by Enbridge Gas, together with those to whom Enbridge Gas sells gas, or on whose behalf, Enbridge Gas distributes, transmits or stores gas. It is impractical to set out the names and addresses of all the customers because they are too numerous.
