Application for an Electricity Wholesale Licence Renewal

INTERIM DECISION AND ORDER

Toyota Motor Manufacturing Canada Inc. (TMMC) filed an application on February 7, 2022, with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) pursuant to section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act* (OEB Act), for an electricity wholesaler licence renewal.

The licence that is a subject of this renewal application was issued to the applicant on February 9, 2017 and remains in force until February 8, 2022. The licence provides that the term may be extended by the OEB.

As per section 57 of the OEB Act, no person can participate in the IESO-administered markets unless licensed to do so. Considering the time required to process an application in accordance with the OEB's established practice and procedures, and considering that TMMC is currently carrying out activities as an electricity wholesaler in Ontario, it is reasonable to issue an interim order to extend the term of the electricity wholesaler licence EW-2017-0014, pending the final disposition of the matter. This Decision and Order does not constitute a final decision on the application.

The applicant is reminded that it carries the onus of filing an application in a timely manner considering the OEB's typical timelines for processing licence applications.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

The term of licence EW-2017-0014 is extended to May 12, 2022, or the date of a final determination of the electricity wholesaler licence application, whichever is earlier. All other conditions of licence EW-2017-0014 remain unchanged.
