## Re: Notice of Hearing for Cost Awards Distributed Energy Resources (DER) Connections Review OEB File No.: EB-2019-0207

This Notice of Hearing for cost awards is in relation to DER Connections Review EB-209-0207 activities from March 2, 2021 to February 2, 2022.

## **Background**

On August 13, 2019, the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) issued a <u>letter</u> commencing an initiative to review its requirements in regard to the connection of distributed energy resources (DERs) by licensed electricity distributors (DER Connections Review). The letter indicated that cost awards would be available under section 30 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, and the OEB has determined that the licensed rate-regulated electricity distributors will pay the costs.

The OEB has issued Decisions on Cost Eligibility on September 10, 2019, September 13, 2019, September 23, 2019 and January 13, 2020 (collectively "the Decisions") that determined the following participants in this consultation process were eligible for cost awards<sup>1</sup>:

The Decisions noted that activities and hours eligible for costs would be determined by the OEB during the course of the process. In its letter establishing a Working Group for the purpose of developing advice regarding DER connection's issues, the OEB indicated costs would be available for those eligible stakeholders that participated in the Working Group. The OEB also confirmed that participation in any sub-groups established by the Working Group are eligible activities.

The maximum number of cost eligible hours per participant to prepare for, attend and report on Working Group Meetings was limited to 1.5 times the meeting time.

The maximum numbers of hours and eligible activities are outlined in Appendix A of this Notice.

In the Decisions, the OEB states the expectation that participants with similar viewpoints coordinate their activities in order to reduce costs, and that this effort will be taken into account during the decision on awards of costs.

## Hearing on Cost Awards

The OEB is initiating a hearing on its own motion to determine the cost awards to eligible participants in the DER Connections Review consultation activities from March 2, 2021 to February 2, 2022. The decision on costs will be made by an OEB staff member with delegated authority under section 6 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998.* The hearing will follow the process set out below.

- Eligible participants shall submit their cost claims by February 25, 2022. The cost claim must be filed with the OEB and one copy is to be served on each licensed electricity distributor. The cost claims must be completed in accordance with section 10 of the OEB's <u>Practice Direction on Cost Awards</u> (Practice Direction).
- 2. Licensed electricity distributors will have until **March 4, 2022** to object to any aspect of the costs claimed. The objection must be filed with the OEB and one copy must be served on the eligible participant against whose claim the objection is being made.
- 3. The eligible participant whose cost claim was objected to will have until **March 11, 2022** to file its reply submission, if any, with the OEB, with a copy of the reply submission to be served on the objecting party.
- 4. The OEB will then issue its decision on cost awards.

The OEB will use the process set out in section 12 of the Practice Direction to implement the payment of the cost awards. The OEB will therefore act as a clearing house for all payments of cost awards in this process.

Parties are responsible for ensuring that any documents they file with the OEB **do not include personal information** (as that phrase is defined in the *Freedom of Information*)

*and Protection of Privacy Act*), unless filed in accordance with rule 9A of the OEB's <u>Rules of Practice and Procedure</u>.

- Filings should clearly state the sender's name, postal address, telephone number and e-mail address.
