
**EB-2021-0205 – Greenstone Pipeline Leave to Construct
Pollution Probe Letter of Comment**

Dear Ms. Marconi:

Pollution Probe is in receipt of Enbridge's update letter dated today for the above-noted proceeding. The Enbridge update exemplifies one of Pollution Probe's concern that there are critical outstanding gaps in the consultation process for this project and that the OEB's Environmental Guidelines and related Ontario Pipeline Coordination Committee (OPCC) process is not functioning effectively or in alignment with prudent expectations. Pollution Probe has trouble understanding how significant projects can be assessed when the consultation process is not adequately conducted.

It is unclear how the Enbridge update at this point of the proceeding will be considered by the panel and Pollution Probe simply wants to confirm that the update from one OPCC agency does not change that there is a lack of positive confirmation from almost all of the OPCC agencies and related permitting authorities. Pollution Probe is not proposing any change to its submission through this letter and is simply providing confirmation that our submissions dated January 11, 2022 remain valid in response to the Enbridge update letter filed today.
