We have already seen what the OEB has done with regard to delivery charges for other utilities - this province - Ontario Power Generation Inc. - the taxpayers owned generator + seller of electricity went from an annual profit of \$42 million in 2004 to \$336 million in 2005 (reported on Feb. 11, 2006).
