Application for an Electricity Generation Licence

DECISION AND ORDER

Ingredion Canada Corporation (Ingredion Canada) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on February 28, 2022 under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for an electricity generation licence renewal.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

Ingredion Canada Corporation is a manufacturer of sweetener, starches, nutrition ingredients, and biomaterial solutions derived from the wet milling and processing of corn and other starch-based materials to a wide range of industries, both domestically and internationally.

The applicant has been previously licensed by the OEB and applied to renew its electricity generation licence, which will expire on May 16, 2022. The applicant is currently licensed to own and operate a 16 MW electricity generation facility, located in London Ontario and is licenced to own a 15 MW electricity generation facility, located in Cardinal, Ontario. The operator of the electricity generation facility, located in Cardinal, Ontario is Cardinal Power of Canada L.P., licensed under EG-2003-0121, to operate the electricity generation facility.

After considering the application and assessing the technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue the electricity generation licence to Ingredion Canada Corporation.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
