DECISION AND ORDER

Mississagi Power Trust filed an application on February 18, 2022, under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act), for renewal of its electricity generation licence.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

Mississagi Power Trust owns and operates four hydroelectric generation facilities, with total installed capacity of 488 MW, located in Northern Ontario. The output from Mississagi Power Trust's generation facilities as well as ancillary services are being contracted out to the Independent Electricity System Operator pursuant to the power purchase and ancillary services agreements.

After considering the application and assessing the technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue an electricity generation licence to Mississagi Power Trust.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
