Re: Request for Intervenor Status and Cost Eligibility

Enbridge Gas Inc.

Annual Update to Five-Year Natural Gas Supply Plan Ontario Energy Board File Number: EB-2022-0072

This letter is in response to your letter dated April 12, 2022, filed on behalf of Building Owners and Managers Association (BOMA), requesting intervenor status and cost eligibility in the above proceeding.

The OEB notes that BOMA's intervention request was filed after the deadline of March 25, 2022, for requesting intervention status and cost eligibility had passed. In its intervention letter, BOMA noted that it is a frequent intervenor in OEB proceedings. BOMA expressed an interest in the following specific aspects of the current proceeding:

- a) The natural gas demand forecast over the transition to a low carbon future will have important implications on pricing, and the OEB's stated issues of cost effectiveness, reliability (which includes security of supply) and support for public policy matter to BOMA members.
- b) Generally, to represent the interests of commercial, office, retail and institutional consumers in this process.

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No objection was received from Enbridge Gas.

BOMA is approved as an intervenor and is eligible to apply for an award of costs under the OEB's *Practice Direction on Cost Awards*. The OEB notes that BOMA did not offer an explanation for its late filing. Boma is reminded to file such requests by the established deadline in future.
