OVERVIEW

Enbridge Gas Inc. (Enbridge Gas) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) dated March 11, 2022 for an order approving or fixing rates for the distribution, transmission, and storage of natural gas effective April 1, 2022, in the Enbridge Gas Distribution (EGD), Union South, Union North East and Union North West rate zones (the Application).¹

On March 24, 2022, the OEB issued its Decision and Rate Order in which it set out the process for cost claims.

The OEB received cost claims from the Canadian Manufacturers & Exporters (CME), the Federation of Rental-housing Providers of Ontario (FRPO) and the Industrial Gas Users Association (IGUA). On April 14, 2022, Enbridge Gas filed a letter stating that it had no objections to the cost claims.

Findings

The OEB has reviewed the cost claims to ensure that they are compliant with the OEB's *Practice Direction on Cost Awards*.

The OEB finds that the cost claims of CME, FRPO and IGUA are reasonable and shall be reimbursed by Enbridge Gas.

¹ Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. (EGD) and Union Gas Limited (Union) amalgamated effective January 1, 2019 to become Enbridge Gas Inc. However, Enbridge Gas Inc. has continued to maintain the existing rates zones of EGD and Union (i.e., EGD, Union North West, Union North East and Union South).

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:

1. Pursuant to section 30 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, Enbridge Gas Inc. shall immediately pay the following amounts to the intervenors for their costs:

•	Canadian Manufacturers & Exporters	\$1,117.57
•	Federation of Rental-housing Providers of Ontario	\$2,237.40
•	Industrial Gas Users Association	\$3,458.93
