**Re: Issuance of the Electricity Distribution Licence, Cancellation of Licences
and Transfer of Rate Orders
OEB File Number: EB-2021-0280**

On March 17, 2022, the OEB issued a Decision and Order approving the amalgamation of Brantford Power Inc. (Brantford Power) and Energy+ Inc. (Energy+). In its decision, the OEB stated that upon receiving notification of the completion of the transaction, the OEB would:

- a) Issue the new electricity distribution licence the new amalgamated entity LDC Amalco to include the service areas formerly served by Brantford Power and Energy +;
- b) Cancel the electricity distribution licences of Brantford Power (ED-2003-0060) and Energy+ (ED-2002-0574); and
- c) Transfer the rate orders of Brantford Power and Energy + to the new amalgamated entity LDC Amalco.

On May 2, 2022, Brantford Power and Energy + notified the OEB that the amalgamation transaction was completed on May 2, 2022 and the new amalgamated entity LDC Amalco was incorporated under the name GrandBridge Energy Inc.

Please find enclosed the electricity distribution licence ED-2021-0280 issued under the name GrandBridge Energy Inc. with effective date May 2, 2022. The electricity distribution licences of Brantford Power (ED-2003-0060) and Energy+ (ED-2002-0574) are cancelled, effective May 2, 2022.

Pursuant to the decision, the rate order of Brantford Power, dated November 25, 2021, and the rate order of Energy +, dated January 12, 2022, are transferred to GrandBridge Energy Inc.
