### **TWIN FALLS LIMITED PARTNERSHIP**

**Application for an Electricity Generation Licence**

**INTERIM DECISION AND ORDER**

Twin Falls Limited Partnership filed an application on April 25, 2022, with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) pursuant to section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act), for a renewal of its electricity generation licence.

Twin Falls Limited Partnership's electricity generation licence EG-2002-0272 is set to expire on May 16, 2022. In order for the applicant to carry out electricity generating activities in Ontario, the applicant requires an electricity generation licence pursuant to section 57 of the OEB Act.

Considering the time required to process an application in accordance with the OEB's established practice and procedures, and considering the applicant's need for a licence to carry out activities as an electricity generator, the OEB finds it expedient to extend the term of the existing licence, pending the final disposition of the matter. This Decision and Order does not constitute a final decision on the application

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

The term of Twin Falls Limited Partnership's EG-2002-0272 is extended on an interim basis until October 1, 2022, or until the final determination of the electricity generation licence application, whichever is earlier. The conditions of licence remain unchanged.
